

AcicN Process For Developing New Guidelines/Recommendations

AcicN members are the writers of its guidelines and recommendations.

The process includes the following activities:

1. A need for certain guidelines/recommendations is identified.
2. The scientific committee will determine the scope and structure of these guidelines /recommendations and announce the need for volunteers.
3. Members (volunteers) will submit the required templates of their willingness to write guidelines/recommendations (including conflict of interests documents).
4. All AcicN members can still submit their opinions/views.
5. Once all information and evidence is collected, the committee will validate the strength of the evidence and the guidelines would be developed and published on the AcicN website for public review
6. Once these steps are completed , the committee will submit the final document to the CAB for approval and publishing.
7. All members names involved in developing these guidelines would be included in the final product.
